

PINE RIVER CITY PLANNING & ZONING MEETING TUES. MARCH 28, 2023, 5:00 P.M.

Meeting was called to order at 5:00pm

1. P.D.

- Paul is looking at adding an additional part time officer to which his budget supports. He provided details as well as a starting wage. This will be placed on the April City Council agenda.

2. MISC.

- ROBERT WALTON - Robert is requesting to have a 'street dance' in July during the 150th celebration at his restaurant located on the corner of Barclay and River Str. Event would be held on Friday 7th & Saturday 8th from 6pm - 10pm outside on the East patio area. He is requesting to block off a section of River Street from Barclay to the alley, basically adjacent to his property lines. Alcohol would be served therefore all rules and regulations related to such events would need to be adhered to. Committee members are in agreement and this will be placed on the April City Council agenda.
- SERVICE DOG REQUEST - A resident wishes to procure a service dog which would require Council approval due to current pet ordinance specifications. Committee discussed amending the current verbiage in the City Pet Ordinance to read as follows; "four (4) pets dogs/cats or any combination thereof". Amended verbiage would alleviate the necessity of a special permit in this instance. Committee members are in agreement and this will be placed on the April City Council agenda.
- LIBRARY MONIES - Tami requested direction from the committee regarding the use of excess budgeted monies. Monies will remain in the Library fund for future use of additional staff. Committee members are in agreement and this will be placed on the April City Council agenda.
- CHICKEN ORDINANCE - Committee continued discussion regarding Chapter 90: Animals. Amendments would include fee schedule changes, pet definition verbiage, chickens and other misc. items. Committee members are in agreement and this will be placed on the April City Council agenda.
- CITY OF PINE RIVER PERSONNEL POLICY - Subject was tabled at this point.

2. PUBLIC WORKS

- CAP. IMP. PROJECTS - Multiple projects were discussed such as City Hall roof & parking lot repair, street paving, river landing access/dock, pickleball, dog park and DNR land acquisition. Bond monies and PWD vehicle replacement schedule were also topics of discussion.
