1. P.R. POLICE

- BUDGET - Paul is requesting, in the event that his department is under budget, to be able to take at least a portion of the monies and put them in the department's Equipment fund for future use in purchasing new cameras.
- POLICE OFFICER - Presented to the committee a letter of resignation from Officer Shawn Birr. Shawn's last 'work' day will be February 5th with the final resignation date of February 7th. Item will be placed on the February Council agenda for official acceptance.
- Officer Ben Sabas will be the school liaison officer.

2. LIBRARY LEASE

- REVIEW NEW LEASE - Council had determined at the January 12th meeting to keep current lease until April if needed.... due to time constraints. Lease changes will be reviewed in depth and brought to the Council meeting once accomplished.

3. PUBLIC WORKS

- DAM PROJECT (BRYAN) - Community meeting intended to be held in March.
Projected project timeline:
March - Bidding will begin.
May 24 - September 3rd - Construction begins and is completed.
Detour may come in to play at that time as well.
- DAM (water) project intended to be done in October.
Discussion was had regarding high flow & low flow concerns.
- Mike discussed using monies from the 'Sewer/Special Projects' fund for possible future water line repairs. Potentially up to \$18K of said fund.
- Advised that Park project/work may likely be on hold until 2022.

4. BLACKLINE REQUEST

- Further discussion was had regarding the request for release of collateral on the Blackline revolving loan. Item will be placed on the February Council agenda.
