LAWN + YARD + FIRE

- **Grass** = 6 inches or shorter
- **Front yards** = free of clutter
- **Fires** must be in designated areas, and no larger than 3ft x 3ft x 3ft. 
- **Keep Trimmed:** shrubs and trees near sidewalks, signs, and streets
